Visitation Fact Sheet

- Residents on infection control precautions are not eligible for routine visitation.
- All visitors will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 by having their temperature taken (temperature must be less than 100°F) and declaring the absence of COVID-19 symptoms.
- Visitation may be declined if a visitor is found to have signs or symptoms of COVID-19.
- Visitors must be 13 years of age or older. If between the ages of 13 and 18, the visitor must be accompanied by someone 18 years of age or older.
- All visitors will be required to use hand sanitizer.
- All visitors will be asked to provide contact information.
- All residents and visitors will be required to wear a mask during visitation, despite vaccination status. If the visitor does not have his or her own mask, a mask will be provided.
- Any visitor that has recently traveled internationally will be required to comply with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) requirements for international travel.

- If the resident and visitor(s) are not vaccinated, then you must refrain from physical contact with your loved one.
- If the resident and visitor(s) are not vaccinated, then six feet of social distancing must be maintained at all times.
- Food and beverages are not permitted during visitation.

Please Note:

- Visitation may be suspended in the event that any resident or employee tests positive for COVID-19, and in the event of increased community spread of COVID-19.
- Any visitor that fails to adhere to the facility visitation protocol will be prohibited from future visitation.
- Other restrictions may be imposed to comply with New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) requirements.
