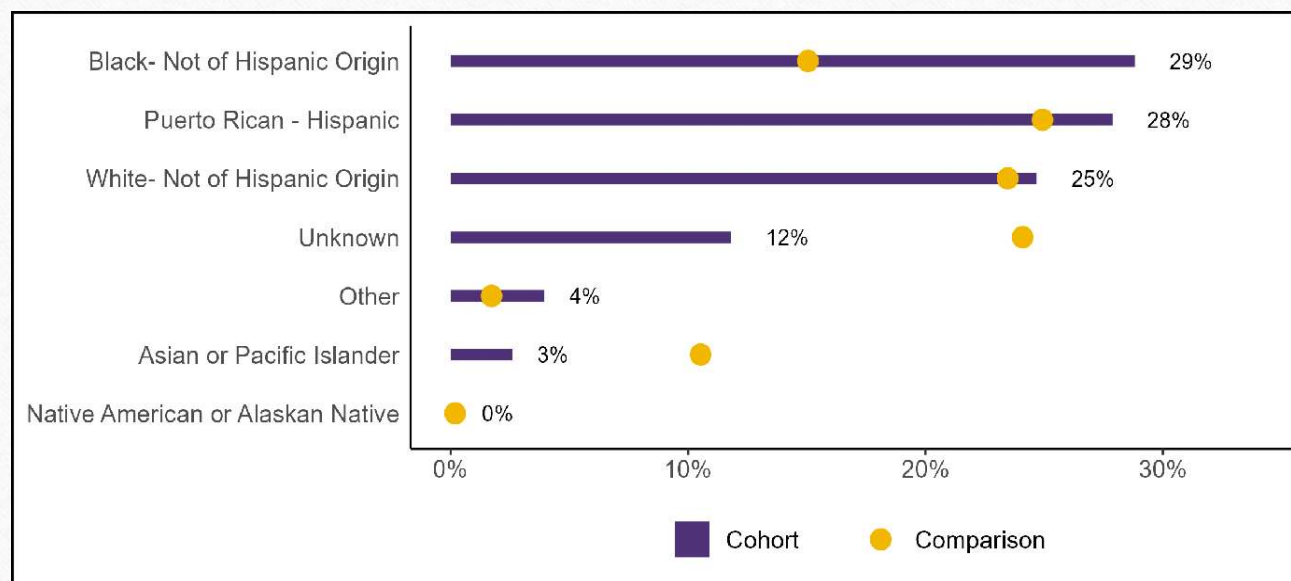


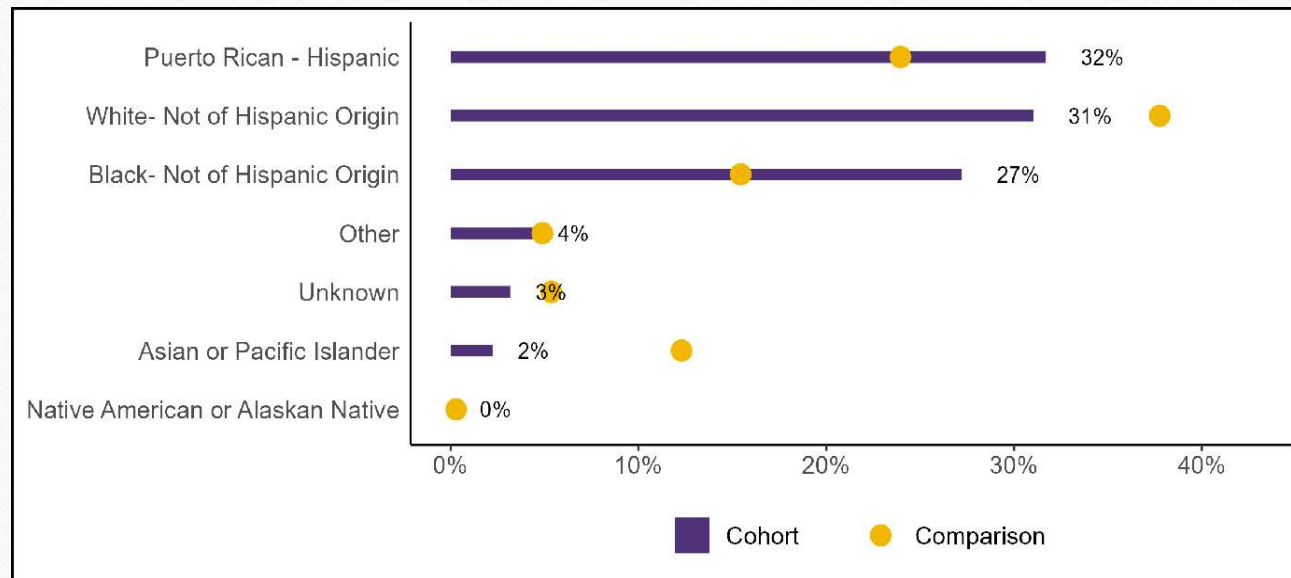

Members Enrolled with Medicaid(Non-Dual)



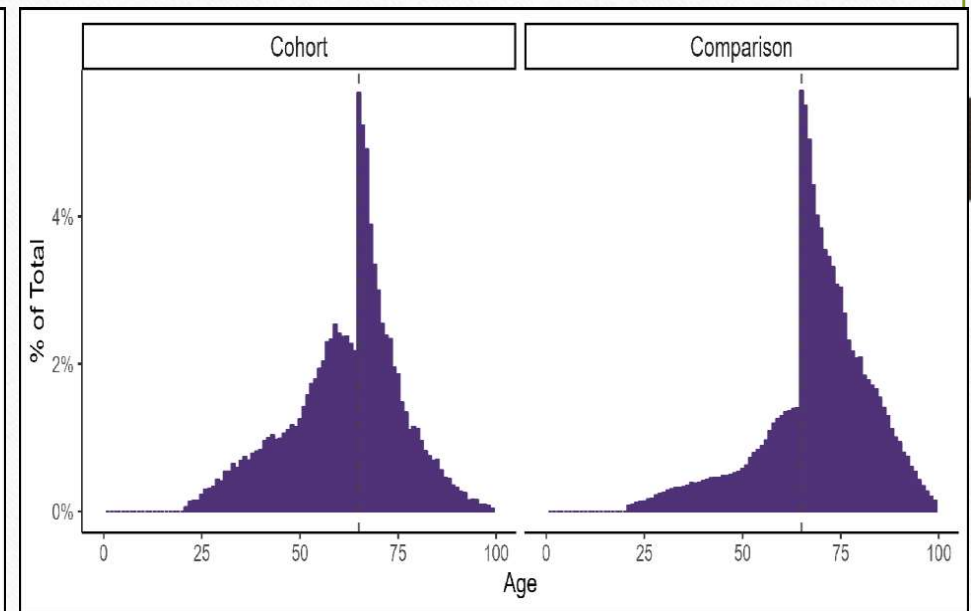
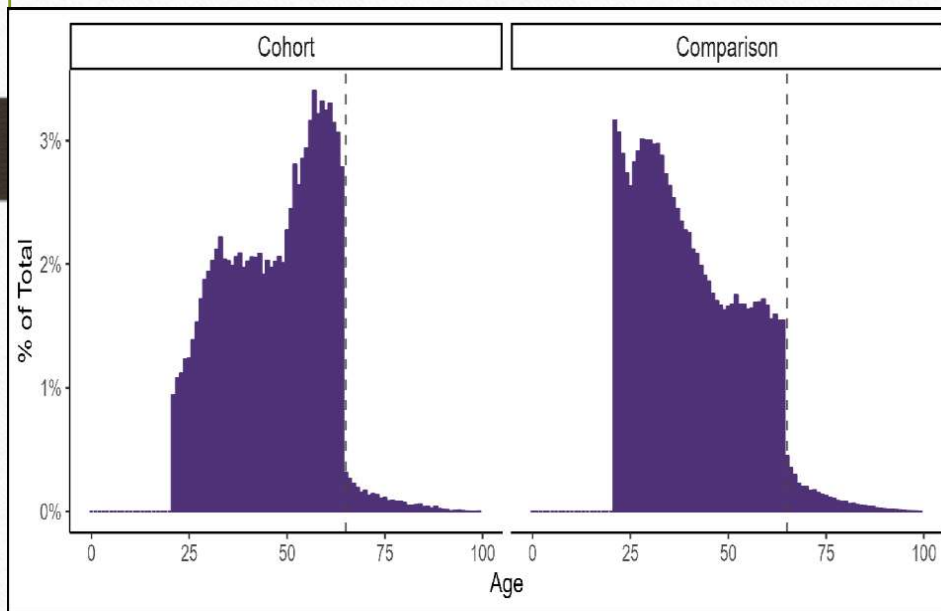
Members Enrolled with Medicaid and Medicare(Dual)
