➤ **Specimen Requirements:**

1. Approximately 2ml of serum is needed for each 6 allergens ordered.
2. The preferred tube type is the 7ml Red top tube. One completely filled 7ml Red top tube is sufficient for approximately 10 allergens.
3. Allow the specimen to clot and centrifuge for 15 minutes.
4. If the specimen is collected in a red top tube, the specimen must be centrifuged and the serum must be separated into a plastic aliquot tube.
