### **Specimen Type**

Blood

### **Preferred Container**

Cord Blood:

Pink EDTA

### **Alternate Container**

Heelstick:

MIBH – Lavender Microtainer

BHSC or OCH – Lavender Microtainer

### **Volume Required**

6 mL

### **Minimum Volume**

1.3 mL

### **Storage Requirements**

If delay in transport is expected, specimens should be kept refrigerated.

### **Transportation Needs**

Specimens should be sent to the laboratory promptly.

Specimens from outreach centers should be kept refrigerated prior to and during shipment.

### **Causes for Rejection**

Mislabeled or unlabeled specimen

### **Reflex Testing**

When the DAT is positive using polyspecific anti-human globulin, a DAT workup is performed and billed (CPT: 86880×4) using monospecific reagents (anti-IgG and anti-Complement).
