# **Specimen Type**

24 hour urine

#### **Preferred Container**

24 hour urine container with 5% NaOH

(Note: Preservative may be added before or after collection)

## **Minimum Volume to Submit for Testing**

Entire collection

At least 10 mL urine needs to be submitted to testing lab.

#### **Storage Requirements**

Keep urine refrigerated during the collection period.

# **Transportation Needs**

Deliver specimen to the laboratory at the end of collection.

If transportation is expected to exceed 1 hour, provisions must be made to keep the urine chilled.

## **Causes for Rejection**

Mislabeled or unlabeled specimen Greater than 10% total volume lost Inappropriate urine preservative used

> 12 hours room temperature

> 24 hours refrigerated
